

ANNUAL SCALBY CHARITY WALK – EASTER MONDAY- RULES AND REGULATIONS 2026

1. Entries are welcome from all locations. There are trophies for residents and for non-residents. All finishers under 18 receive a signed certificate.
2. To make sure of your eligibility for a trophy we advise that you enter by 5pm on Saturday 5th^h April 2026.
3. Entrants who are 14 to 18 years of age on 6th April 2026 can enter and walk on their own but must have a signed parental agreement.
4. Entrants under 14 years of age on 6th April 2026 must walk with their family group and the lead member of that walking family group will be responsible for family members.
5. The entrance fee for each entrant over 18 years old on 6th April 2026 is £15 in advance or £17 on the day.
6. The entrance for each entrant under 18 years old on 6th April 2026 is £5 in advance or £6 on the day.
7. Dogs are welcome but must be kept under control on a short lead.
8. The route to be walked is from The Plough, Scalby on North Street via Stony Lane onto the main Scalby to Cloughton Road (A171). The first call is the Three Jolly Sailors, then on to the Red Lion at Cloughton which is the end of the outward journey. You then turn back towards Scalby calling the Blacksmiths Arms Cloughton. From the Blacksmiths you go left on to Scalby Road (A171) until you reach the Station Lane junction. At the Station Lane junction turn left and walk to join the old Whitby to Scarborough railway line (now called the Cinder Track) until you reach the junction with Field Lane, Burniston. You then follow Field Lane until the Cross Lane junction where you turn left. At the end of Cross Lane, you turn left onto Burniston Road (A165) and after a few yards reach your final pub The Oak Wheel. From the Oak Wheel you follow Burniston Road until you re-join the Cinder Track to Lancaster Way, then turn left onto Field Close Road and right on to Station Lane in Scalby. You follow Station Lane to the junction with Scalby Road then turn right for 20 yards to cross Scalby Road at the pedestrian sanctuary and turn left and then right onto High Street and cross the finish line at The Plough.
9. Half a pint of beer, lager, squash or water is to be consumed by all adult entrants. Under 18 entrants do not have to finish their squash or water.
10. All competitors must walk “heel and toe”, they must not run.
11. Competitors must affix their number to their front, and it must be visible.
12. Entrants will be handicapped on age and past performance.
13. Any objections must be made by 2pm 6th April 2026.
14. Competitive walkers start at 10am. Fun walkers start between 10.30am and 11am,
15. Official time keeping will terminate at 2pm.
16. The organiser’s decisions on any objections will be final.
17. Trophies, Draw Raffle prizes and Fancy-Dress prizes will be awarded at 2.45pm at The Plough.
